Description	A new District Technician (Forest Coordinator) will expand our technical assistance to forestry land owners and aid in coordinating BMP implementation across the Snake Watershed with our partnering agencies as directed by the Snake 1W1P

With the completion of the Kettle & Snake River Landscape Stewardship Plans; priority areas within Kanabec County have been identified for enhanced targeting and water quality protection efforts.
