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Grant Activity - Water Storage & Treatment – New District Forester / SRWMB Coordinator			
Description	A new District Forester / Snake River Coordinator will expand our technical assistance to forestry land owners and aid in coordinating BMP implementation across the Snake Watershed with our partnering agencies as directed by the Snake 1W1P currently under development, to be completed June 2022. Our District Forester will provide forestry technical assistance, education and forestry best management practice planning and implementation. (This position may be contracted out to our SWCD partners within the Rum River Watershed.) With the completion of the Kettle & Snake River Landscape Stewardship Plans; priority areas within Kanabec County have been identified for enhanced targeting and water quality protection efforts. The Snake River Watershed Landscape Stewardship Plan (12/2018) on pages 29-30, implementation targets to provide Forest Stewardship Planning acres (600/yr.) and SFIA enrollment (200 ac/yr), tree sales for increased tree planting and technical assistance on forestry BMPs.
